My name is Janine Sheaffer and I attended the Greater Scioto Valley women's walk to Emmaus #36 and I sat at the table of Hannah. My walk was in June 2006. My sponsor had told me that the Lord wanted me to leave what was troubling me there at the walk. I thought about it and felt for sure I knew what it was to leave there. When it was time for what I now know is "dying communion", I thought I have this. Little did I know. I was waiting my turn to go up and I heard our walk lay director say she was tired of feeling inadequate. I may have been the only one who heard her, but it broke me. I was still feeling inadequate from a divorce six years before. I had not been good enough to keep my husband. I had forgiven him years before my walk but I was still emotionally damaged. What I learned from the walk is that I am a precious child of the Lord and He loves me and does not see me as lacking.

My walk helped me be stronger and motivated me to be a leader for my church and the Emmaus community. July 2018, I was elected as Sponsorship chairman. My goal is to continue to educate the expectations of a Sponsor with training sessions throughout the year.
