#### On the Road to Emmaus

<sup>13</sup> Now that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup> They were talking with each other about everything that had happened. <sup>15</sup> As they talked and discussed these things with each other, Jesus himself came up and walked along with them; <sup>16</sup> but they were kept from recognizing him.

<sup>17</sup> He asked them, "What are you discussing together as you walk along?"

They stood still, their faces downcast. <sup>18</sup> One of them, named Cleopas, asked him, "Are you the only one visiting Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?"

<sup>19</sup> "What things?" he asked.

"About Jesus of Nazareth," they replied. "He was a prophet, powerful in word and deed before God and all the people. <sup>20</sup> The chief priests and our rulers handed him over to be sentenced to death, and they crucified him; <sup>21</sup> but we had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel. And what is more, it is the third day since all this took place. <sup>22</sup> In addition, some of our women amazed us. They went to the tomb early this morning <sup>23</sup> but didn't find his body. They came and told us that they had seen a vision of angels, who said he was alive. <sup>24</sup> Then some of our companions went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said, but they did not see Jesus."

<sup>25</sup> He said to them, "How foolish you are, and how slow to believe all that the prophets have spoken! <sup>26</sup> Did not the Messiah have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?" <sup>27</sup> And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

<sup>28</sup> As they approached the village to which they were going, Jesus continued on as if he were going farther. <sup>29</sup> But they urged him strongly, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening; the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them.

<sup>30</sup> When he was at the table with them, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it and began to give it to them. <sup>31</sup> Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight. <sup>32</sup> They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

<sup>33</sup> They got up and returned at once to Jerusalem. There they found the Eleven and those with them, assembled together <sup>34</sup> and saying, "It is true! The Lord has risen and has appeared to Simon." <sup>35</sup> Then the two told what had happened on the way, and how Jesus was recognized by them when he broke the bread. Luke 24:13-35

Remember your walk to Emmaus? When were your eyes opened to the immense Love of God? When did you really see Jesus? The time of silence? Dying Communion? The Scripture reading? The clowns? Candlelight? All the agape? The singing? Were our hearts burning within us? Has our fire gone out?

## **Springfield Area Emmaus**

Each community must have its own local Emmaus Board of Directors. Insofar as they take responsibility for enabling Emmaus weekends in their locality, it is recommended that the Board be structured as a "Working Board" described in the outlines for Springfield Area Emmaus Board of Directors. The Board of Directors of each new Emmaus Community should adopt bylaws which set forth the structure and rules of operation for the Board of Directors. The bylaws which follow are those set forth for the Springfield Area Emmaus Communities, originally published September 16, 1992 and most recently revised at the March 2018February 17, 2019 board meeting to be effective on April 17, June 10, 20198.

## BYLAWS OF THE SPRINGFIELD AREA EMMAUS COMMUNITY

Revised effective June 10 April 21, 2018 2019

#### ARTICLE V. COMMITTEES

Section 1. The Board of Directors consists of Board members to chair the following committees: Registration, Sponsorship, Good ShepherdFourth Day, Kitchen, Purchasing/Supply, Social, Logistics, Worship, OutreachNurturing, Agape, Supplies, Music, Newsletter, Chrysalis, Kairos, and the High Street United Methodist Church Representative.

# Guidance for the Community:

In accordance with Springfield Area Emmaus By-Laws, ARTICLE VII, *AMENDMENT*, the board proposes the above amendment. If anyone in the community objects to the proposed change, a petition describing the objection, with signatures of at least twenty-five (25) community members, must be received by the Community Lay Director, **Gene Porter, gporter1@woh.rr.com**, within sixty (60) days of amendment posting date (18 April 2019). If an objection petition is received, the amendment is not enacted. If the Board wishes to submit the amendment to the entire Community for a vote, it may do so by posting that intent in the newsletter 30 days prior to the gathering where the vote occurs. A simple majority of votes cast by the membership present at the gathering will decide the matter. If no objection petition is received, the amendment is enacted after the completion of 60 days from the posting date.

**Note** – Chrysalis and Kairos are to become committees under the Nurturing chairperson. Other changes are renaming of roles and combining Purchasing and Supply. No other changes to the By-Laws are proposed at this time.
