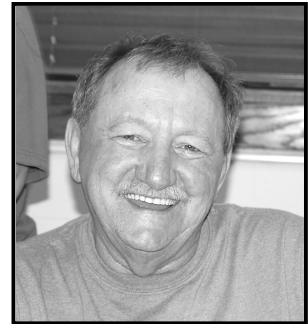


## OUR LEADERSHIP CHAIR & HIS LOVELY WIFE
